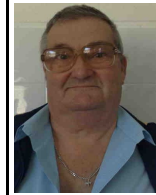


## Staff Matters

Notice is hereby given that a Special General Meeting of the Sea View Golf Club (Inc) will be held at the Club House on **Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2008**, commencing at **6.00 pm**.

The purpose of this meeting is twofold:

1. To report on the progress of the irrigation project and financing issues
2. To report on the Next Generation development.

### Irrigation:

As most members will be aware the Club sought funding of this project through loans from the Town of Cottesloe. At the recent Council meeting a loan of \$380,000 was supported. This loan, coupled with club funds on hand, is approximately \$70,000 below the estimated cost of the project.

The Club is going to look at its funding alternatives but in the event of these alternatives failing another levy of up to a maximum of \$70,000 will need to be raised from members. A bridging loan will be negotiated as a short term measure.

As a result members will be asked to vote on the attached motion.

### Next Generation:

Following the Special Meeting held in February this year, the Board appointed a Special Project Committee to progress negotiations with Next Generation Clubs of Australia.

Sufficient progress has been made during these negotiations that it is now time to provide members with a detailed briefing as to the current situation. To this effect Mr Bill Guile, Director of Operations, Next Generation Clubs Australia will be in attendance to report to members.

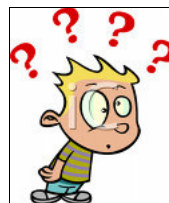
### 2nd Moiety Fees are Now Due!

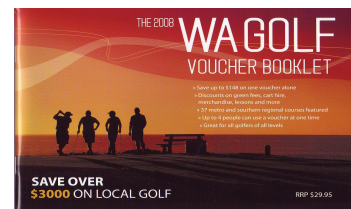

## Course

### RETICULATION

We have had our loan application approved to be supported by the Town of Cottesloe, to enable us to fund these works. We have signed the contract with the contractors and you no doubt have seen the large piles of pipes stored adjacent to the carpark. Work is scheduled to commence on Monday 7th July, commencing on the 3<sup>rd</sup> fairway and heading south. We will be posting up a copy of the planned works schedule and a copy of the site drawings for your information during the week of 4<sup>th</sup> July. Work is planned to take approx twelve (12) weeks and we will during this time experience some inconvenience to our normal play, in order to comply with the requirements of the Dept of Safety.

Your Match committee has agreed with the contractors that the hole that they are working on will be closed to play. During the closure we will play the short Practice fairway hole as a replacement for the hole that is closed, the score recorded will be recorded on the score card against the hole that is out of play. This hole will be played at the completion of the 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> hole. Obviously when the 9<sup>th</sup>/18<sup>th</sup> is being worked on (which is in the middle of the works) the short hole will be played after the 8<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup>.
