New Rule Book



If you do not have a copy of the **Player's Edition of the Rules of golf Effective January 2019** ask for one from the office.

Rule 7.3 Lifting Your Ball to Identify It (Page 47)

If a ball might be yours but you cannot identify it as it lies, you may lift the ball to identify it **BUT** the spot of the ball must first be *marked*, and the ball must not be cleaned more than needed to identify it (**except** on the *putting green*).

Rule 14.1 Marking, Lifting and Cleaning Ball (Page 76)

14.1a Before lifting your ball under a Rule requiring it to be *replaced* on its original spot, you must mark the spot, which means to

- Place a ball-marker right behind or right next to your ball, or
- Hold a club on the ground right behind or right next to our ball.

If you lift your ball without *marking* its spot, mark its pot in a wrong way or make a stroke with a *ball-marker* left in place you get **one penalty stroke.**
